- Kite and craft making for the kids.

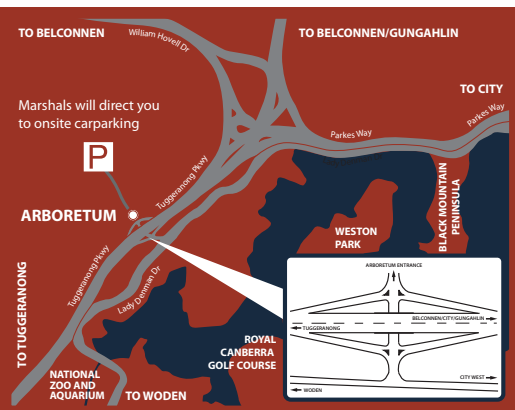
